NEWS FROM MLS.ENTOMO

Dear network members,

This is a short newsletter, with three points.

First, mainly for entomologists working in Sahara and in West Africa Sahel: the final PDF version of the

You can download the PDF via the doi, then click on the button “Open Access” (bottom left). Entomologists may print the PDF, on A4 or A5 format of paper; they may also use it on the computer screen, and thus benefit from the hypertext links.

Because these identification keys target mainly French speaking countries, the text is in French.

Once again, if you received a working version, about two months ago, be kind enough to delete it (because with several mistakes), and use the final one.

Second, all the mosquito plates of photographs used in the recent identification exercises (EQA) are now searchable and downloadable at:

Go down in the window to “Photographic plates”

And click on “HERE” at the end of the sentence "The illustrations of the 56 adult plates and 11 larval plates in high definition can be downloaded HERE".
