Capacity Building strategy: FETP

- 10-weeks of theoretical –plus-practical sessions
- Two-years-on-job-training under the mentorship of seniors:
 - ✓ outbreak investigations,
 - ✓ surveillance systems,
 - √ research project development,
 - ✓ international assignments,
 - ✓ and scientific writing
- Training support to senior mentors (ToT's)
- Able to cascade to local workforce

Results Previous phase



- Two cohorts with 22 Fellows graduated, fulfilling the following assignments:
 - More than 30 outbreaks investigated,
 - > 25 surveillance systems implemented or newly evaluated,
 - > 22 research projects conducted,
 - More than 40 international missions conducted.
- 12 ToT and 250 seniors trained.
- 8 established training sites + 4 appraised
- 3 Annual Scientific Conferences (more than 400 participants)



Progress P74 MediPIET current phase





- Third Cohort launched in May 2019 with 15 fellows from 11 countries
- 3 Modules done in Madrid, Belgrade and Tirana
- 3 following modules, organization ongoing
- 1 ToT organization ongoing
- Face to face Training Center Forum organization ongoing
- Synergies and collaboration with other Networks (MediLAB Secure, CBRN CoE projects, JA SHARP, TEPHINET-EMPHNET, WHO, GOARN)
