### Rationale

The One Health (OH) approach, i.e. a multidisciplinary and multi-sectoral approach, is considered crucial for strengthening prevention and preparation capabilities for potential threats to human and animal health, also considering the protection of our ecosystem.

The global governance of One Health is coordinated by a quadripartite of United Nations organizations: the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the Environment Program (UNEP), the World Health Organization (WHO) and the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH).

The Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS) has been involved for several years in initiatives and projects aimed at encouraging the adoption of One Health approaches in prevention, preparation and response plans to threats to health, both at a national and international level (One Health - ISS).

It is in this context that the international workshop “Building the One Health Work force in the European Region” is inserted, to which experts from the academic world, national institutions and international organizations were invited, including representatives of WHO, WHOA, FAO and UNEP.

### Aims

The Workshop intends to discuss, with relevant experts, the skills necessary for the workforce involved in the development and execution of prevention and preparedness plans for health threats, to strengthen operational capabilities, in accordance with One Health principles.

Furthermore, the workshop also aims to characterize and define the One Health workforce in the European region.

### Working method

The workshop includes experts' presentations, round tables and working groups.

At the end of the initiative, the recommendations emerging from the work of the technical groups will be provided, aimed at developing training plans that guarantee the acquisition and strengthening of the skills necessary to implement prevention and preparation strategies, in accordance with the integrated approaches envisaged by One Health.
